

Mark this FREE PATTERN on your own **Design Wall of Hobbs Heirloom Batting** (70"x90" minimum for 2.5" squares) See chart for other size options.

Fold, press, and mark **Vertical Center Line** with Sharpie Permanent Marker.

Measure down 31" from top center, make Permanent Sharpie Mark for **center of Cross**, and mark the **Horizontal Line** for the cross beam of the Cross.

Using a 5"x24" Ruler, and FriXion heat erasable Highlighter, draw **generous 5" spacings** (leave a little Wiggle Room)... use wide width of marker, see the entire width of previous line before placing the ruler again... creating a little extra space for re-arranging the fabric squares.

Each 5"x5" Big Square will hold four Small Squares of fabric (2.5" each)

Draw the outer edges of the Entire Quilt:

Five marks up from the center cross point at generous 5" spaces, and **one mark at 2.5"** to **top of quilt**.

Ten marks down from the center cross point at generous 5" spaces, and **one mark at 2.5"** to **bottom of quilt**.

Six marks out left & right from the center of cross point at generous 5" spaces to **edge of quilt**.

Extend all the vertical lines from top to bottom, to draw columns on the design wall.

Extend all the horizontal lines from side to side.

(Ceramic tile floor grout lines help stay straight and square!)

NOW COUNT INDIVIDUAL 2.5" SMALL SQUARES with FriXion heat erasable Highlight Markers.

Mark the **Top of Cross** at **Five Small Squares up** from center cross point.

Mark the **Bottom of Cross** at **Fourteen Small Squares down** from the center cross point.

Mark the **Edges of Cross Beam** at **Six Small Squares out** left and right.

See photo... **Mark outlines of Cross**... center your 5' ruler on center horizontal line, marking at 2.5" parallel on each side of the center lines to the edges of Cross.

The **Main Cross** will have two rows of 2.5" squares across, and two columns of 2.5" squares down.

The **Dark Outline** of Cross will be one round of 2.5" squares (Cross is now 4 rows, 4 columns).

The **Light Outline** of Cross will be one round of White, Gold, or lightest shades of Swooshes of Colors.

The rest of the background will be divided into Swooshes of Colors representing the Liturgical Colors for the church year. Each color section should have light, med, and dark tones ... see photo or my videos.

This quilt is best with a wide variety of scrappy squares, so make it uniquely yours! Arrange your fabric squares, and use PaolaJo's Clotheslining Technique to Stack and Label sections of your quilt into smaller sewable blocks.
